

Do Not Disturb on Android

Allow calls from contacts only

1

Search for "Do Not Disturb" in Settings

The location varies by phone — searching is the easiest way to find it regardless of your Android brand

2

Turn on Do Not Disturb

Toggle DND on

3

Tap "People" and/or "Calls"

Look for a People or Calls section within DND settings

4

Select "Contacts"

Under "Calls that can interrupt" (or similar) — tap Contacts

What happens next

- Calls from your contacts will ring through normally
- All other calls are silenced and sent to voicemail
- Exact wording may vary slightly depending on your Android phone

Hearing Google Maps Audio During DND

A

Go to DND → Apps → Add apps

Look for "Apps" or "Exceptions" in your DND settings

B

Add Google Maps (and any other apps you need)

Maps uses media volume and may already work — add it here if not
Tip: you can allow any app this way, not just Google Maps
